This September marks the 6th annual Camp 911. Over the past 5 years, the children have learned safety techniques and how to get through emergency situations. Camp 911 has focused on bicycle safety, fire safety, and general emergency safety: knowledge the children will keep for a lifetime. The 2011 Camp 911 will focus on Rural and Farm Safety including the following courses:

- Proper use of 911 • First Aid • Animal Safety
• Machinery Safety • Police Awareness • ATV Safety
• Electrical Safety • Weather Safety

Camp 911 is a 501(c)(3) organization and is seeking donations to assist with Camp 911 in 2011. All donations will be used exclusively to benefit the Camp 911 students. No salaries will be paid from the donations. Every 2nd and 3rd grade student in Iroquois County attending the following schools will participate:

In 2010 each of the approximately 850 students received a take home reflective book bag containing a Camp 911 T-shirt, fire helmet, emergency response pamphlets, safety stickers, rulers, crayons, coloring books, coupons from local businesses, and pencils. Each student has spent priceless time with our local experienced emergency personnel, which has helped them to understand the importance of safety and being prepared for an emergency. Camp 911 in 2011 will be focused on Rural and Farm Safety.

There have been several instances when children who participated in Camp 911 were able to use the skills learned in real life situations. A student was home alone and cut himself on a soup can lid and knew to call 911 for assistance. Several students saw a van with a suspicious subject in it and called out "Stranger Danger" and ran back into the school. Most recently a student was able to save her grandfather's life using the knowledge she gained from a previous Camp!
