The Iroquois County Public Health Department (ICPHD) is conducting a full-scale exercise on June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016 from 9 AM to 11 AM. ICPHD is requesting volunteers to participate. This exercise is being conducted in conjunction with local partners and multiple state agencies. The purpose of this exercise is to practice mass dispensing of medications to the entire population of Iroquois County. ICPHD needs volunteers to drive through the dispensing site in which pretend "medication" will be dispensed at the Iroquois County Fairgrounds, located at 1390 East 2000 North Road outside of Crescent City.

People can volunteer as individuals or as groups. Participants will be able to experience how the Iroquois County Public Health Department will respond to the event of a biological release or mass outbreak, and how ICPHD strives to ensure the health and safety of the public.
