Health Department Announces Drive-Thru Flu Clinic

Iroquois County -The Iroquois County Public Health Department (ICPHD) is offering a drive-thru clinic on Wednesday, October 5, 2016 at the First Christian Church in Watseka. “We are excited about providing this easy access clinic,” states Vonda Pruitt, RN, Director of Nursing for the health department. The public is encouraged to enjoy the comfort and convenience of staying in their vehicle while receiving the flu shot. People with mobility issues are especially encouraged to take advantage of this drive-thru clinic.

The church is located at 546 North 6th Street in Watseka. The public is asked to enter the church parking lot from the 6th Street entrance and follow the traffic cones.

As in the past, it is requested that those attending a clinic wear clothing that provides easy access to the vaccination site. The cost is \$35 per dose. If you have coverage for the flu vaccine through Medicare or one of the following listed insurance companies, the Iroquois County Public Health Department can bill them directly. ICPHD can currently bill Aetna, BlueCross/Blue Shield of IL PPO, Health Alliance, HealthLink PPO and HealthLink HMO. Please bring your card with you. The health department will be able to bill Cigna as of October 15 and is currently working on a contract with United Healthcare. A receipt will be provided to enable those with other insurance coverage to obtain reimbursement.

The health department continues to offer walk-in flu clinics at the Administrative Center at 1001 E. Grant St., Watseka on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9 A.M. to 4 P.M. throughout the flu season.
